**INAUGURAL SEASON EVALUATION CAMP**  
**MAY 25-27, 2007**

The Kenai River Brown Bears, members of the NAHL, who will play their home games at the Soldotna Sports Center, are proud to announce their first inaugural season evaluation camp to be held Memorial Day weekend. The camp will be held at the ConocoPhillips / City of Kenai Multi-Purpose Facility located at 9775 Kenai Spur Highway in the town of Kenai, Alaska. The camp will consist of three complete days of practice sessions, dry land training, goalie evaluation and competitive round robin games. Players will report for camp Friday morning May 25<sup>th</sup> and the camp will end Sunday evening May 27<sup>th</sup>.

The camp will be run by the Brown Bear's Director of Hockey Operations, Todd Brost. Brost brings a wealth of hockey playing and coaching knowledge to the newest NAHL team. He played junior hockey in the BCJHL with teammates Joe Murphy and Brett Hull. He then accepted a scholarship to the University of Michigan and captained the Wolverines in his junior and senior seasons. After that, he played 4 seasons with Team Canada and won a Silver Medal in the 1992 Winter Olympics. He completed his playing career by playing 3 seasons of pro hockey in the IHL, ECHL, and in Europe. Since then Brost has coached 10 years of pro hockey in the CHL and UHL winning two championships.
